SCARF WEAVING - weave 2 scarves on floor looms. No prior weaving necessary. \$95.00 plus supplies \$32.00. A two day class 9:30-4:30

SPINNING - on a wheel. \$40.00 plus supplies \$6.00, wheel rental \$5.00. 12:30-5:30

APPALACHIAN BASKET - weave a melon basket in 5 hours. \$35.00 plus supplies \$10.00

POTATO BASKET - weave a 10" handleless basket in 5 hours. Originally designed for storing potatoes in the root cellar. \$35.00 plus supplies \$10.00

WICKER BASKET - make a small basket learning 3 techniques using round reed. Tools and supplies provided \$26.00

BOOK BINDING – Adhesive and non-adhesive books will be made (pamphlet, accordion and Japanese stitched). \$40.00 plus supplies \$15.00

RAG RUG WEAVING – Weave 4 types of rag rugs or table runners. These techniques are log cabin, ripsmatta, block and tabby. Previous knowledge of four harness weaving required. Projects are woven outside of class time. \$110.00 plus supplies. **Mon-Tues April 19-20 and Mon May 17**

Other classes: Knitting, Jewelry, Papermaking and Lavender Wands
