

Fiber Retreat Scarf

This great little scarf was designed by Evelyn Clarke for my Exotic Fiber class. You can keep knitting until you have the length you want. Use your sample yarns to make a slanted scarf:

Cast on a multiple of 12 plus 2 edge stitches.

Row 1 & 2: Knit.

Row 3: K1, K2tog, K5, *P6, K6,* P5, M1 (lift the bar between the stitches, put on needle and P in back of that loop), K1

Row 4: K1 *K6, P6*, K1

Repeat rows 3 & 4 to desired length

Last two rows: K
