Getting There

From the North: Take I-5 Burlington exit to Hwy 20 Whidbey Is & Anacortes. Follow Hwy 20 & Whidbey signs to Oak Harbor (about 1 hour). In the central part of town, after seeing North Whidbey Middle School and field on your left, turn right at the stoplight on Whidbey Avenue. Drive approximately .8 mile, turn right on Jib Street. Drive .2 mile until the road terminates at Oak Harbor High School. Follow Weavers Guild signs to Parker Hall.

From the South: Take I-5 Exit to SR 526 and Whidbey Island. Follow RS 526 past the Boeing Plant. There will be a Whidbey Island ferry sign at the stop light at 84th Ave. Turn right. Turn right again on SR 525 and follow it to the ferry dock at Mukilteo. On the Island, follow the highway north up Whidbey past Coupeville, and on into Oak Harbor (about 1 hour). In the central part of town, after seeing K-Mart on your left, turn left at the stoplight on Whidbey Avenue. Drive approximately .8 mile, turn right on Jib Street. Drive .2 mile until the road terminates at Oak Harbor High School. Follow Weavers Guild signs to Parker Hall.
