Saturday – Color Wheel Magic

Colors are magic in the way they spark opinions. But if we step back and use a color wheel, we can gain some insights. The color wheel can help us choose colors, help us see what mixing colors will do, and help us explain our color choices. We will take a look at how and why we pick colors, both with a color wheel and without. I will share my color experiments along the way.

Sunday – Spin Braids into Gold

I bet you have one (or a few) of those 4-ounce space-dyed braids in your stash that caught your eye but now you have no idea how to approach it. Bring it, your wheel/spindles, and some handcards (if you have a pair), and see how many ways you can transform it into colorful yarn. We will explore splitting, singles, fractals, neutrals, grist, and editing braids to get the yarn of your dreams.

Getting There

From the North: Take I-5 Burlington exit to Hwy 20 Whidbey Is & Anacortes. Follow Hwy 20 & Whidbey signs to Oak Harbor (about 1 hour). In the central part of town, after seeing North Whidbey Middle School and field on your left, turn right at the stop light on Whidbey Avenue. Drive approximately .8 mile, turn right on Jib Street. Drive .2 mile until the road terminates at Oak Harbor High School. Parking is right there.

The event is in the GYM again this year. Enter through the normal doors and go straight to the gym.

From the South: Take I-5 north to the Mukilteo ferry exit, just south of Everett. Follow the signs to the ferry. Once on the Island, drive north on the highway about 36 miles. As you come into Oak Harbor, turn left on Swantown Road. After .4 miles take a right on SW Heller Str. After almost a mile, turn right on NW 2nd Ave, and the school will be on your right. Drive to the far end of the campus to find the parking area.
